doesn't → does not

He / She / It does not live in Paris.

We use the Present simple for things

- we habitually do. (I go to school in the morning. / She has a shower in the morning.)
- we do on special occasions. (Mum makes a big cake for my birthday. / We decorate the house for Christmas.)
- we don't expect to change. [Dad helps mum to do the cleaning. / We live in a big house.]


