He <b>plays</b> hockey.	He _____ basketball.
She _____ hockey.	She <b>doesn't play</b> basketball.
It <b>plays</b> with the toy.	It _____ with the ball.
We _____ hockey.	We <b>don't play</b> basketball.
They <b>play</b> hockey.	They _____ _____ basketball.

### Remember!

You can't use contracted forms in formal letters or documents.

**don't → do not**

*I / We / You / They do not like soup.*

**doesn't → does not**

*He / She / It does not live in Paris.*

### Remember!

She ~~does~~ not lives.

### We use the Present simple for things

- we habitually do. (*I go to school in the morning. / She has a shower in the morning.*)
- we do on special occasions. (*Mum makes a big cake for my birthday. / We decorate the house for Christmas.*)
- we don't expect to change. (*Dad helps mum to do the cleaning. / We live in a big house.*)

## Spelling rule after the third person singular (*he, she, it*)

Most verbs	Verbs ending in -s, -sh, -x or -ch
verb + -s	verb + -es
get gets	kiss kisses
work works	wash washes
sleep sleeps	fix fixes
play plays	watch watches
Verbs go and do	Verbs ending in a consonant + -y
verb + -es	change -y to -i + -es
go goes	study studies
do does	tidy tidies

## Before ↔ After

1 do my homework

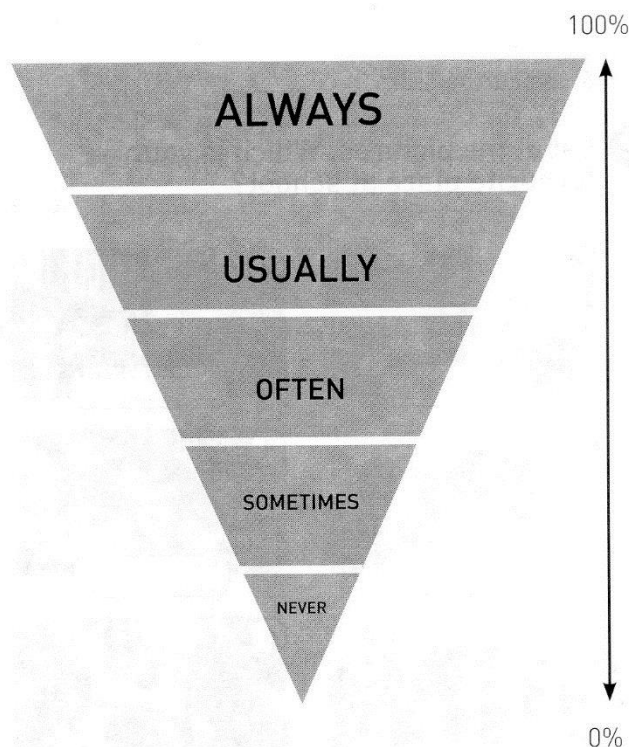
2 watch TV

I do my homework **before** I watch TV.

=

I watch TV **after** I do my homework.

## Adverbs of frequency



### We use

- adverb of frequency + verb  
*We always study for tests.*  
**BUT**
- verb *to be* + adverb of frequency  
*She is never angry.*

### Pay attention!

**Want + infinitive with to**

*I want to sleep.*

*I don't want to watch TV.*

*She wants to play the piano.*

*She doesn't want to read a book.*
